

## Desktop Mapping Java Download

Download the correct version of Java for PC here:  
<http://java.sun.com/products/archive/j2se/5.0/index.html>

Apple Mac's update Java automatically and OS recommend Version 1.4.2 as a minimum requirement.

Once installed - please configure the Java accordingly:

### For PC

- Via the 'Start' Menu on your PC, choose the 'Control Panel' and then the Java Plugin (the icon looks like a coffee cup!)
- On the 'General' Tab (should be the first one)...choose to 'Delete Files' (agree to all the file types selected) and then open the 'Settings' section:
- Where it states 'Amount of Disk-Space' to use, select 'Maximum' and type '0' (as in zero) as the value.
- Jar Compression should be set to the 'None' end of the scale. When done, click on 'OK' to close that part.
- Click 'OK' to exit, and 'OK' to exit the Java Plugin Control Panel.

### For Mac

- Open the Hard Disk ['about this Mac' section] - go to: Applications , then Utilities, then Java, choose 1.4.2 Settings
- In the Java Control Panel, you will find three tabs... Use the middle one called 'Cache' (By default, 'Enable Caching' will be selected) - select it if it is disabled.
- Select the 'Clear' button, and then agree to clear all temporary files.
- In this section, change the 'Size' option to 'Maximum' (unless done already) and enter the number 0 for the value. So you will have a Maximum Size of 0mb.
- Then disable/deselect the 'Enable Caching' button (other buttons should 'grey-out' at this point).
- Select 'Apply'
- You can then close the Java Control Panel.

Additional note: If Mac users are still having java/mapping problems after these settings have been made, it's possible that the Java JRE Parameters need to be configured - please contact the NMC Helpdesk (below) if required.
